<p data-bbox="193 943 304 976"><u>Dining</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Can you have a meal with residents? 2) Does the staff take time to coax reluctant eaters? 3) Are special diets observed? 4) Is there a choice of cooked meal/sandwich type food? 5) Can food be served elsewhere if resident does not like to eat in the dining room? 6) If a resident does not want to eat at a set time is the food saved for when the resident does want to eat?
