To meet Janice's changing needs her Plan of care needs to be totally flexible. The one to one person assessing moods and wants on a minute-by-minute basis

Harness to be used when in wheelchair (wheelchair is only to be used in an emergency) Seat belt to be used when in hydro-tilt chair

Give your full attention to Janice during her one to one care. Spend time talking, playing, reading, massaging, and using tactile type activities etc.

When in the soft room ensure the padding is viable.

Alternate sitting on the beanbag or on the mattress with Janice.

The hydro-tilt chair is used for her meal times and walking inside or out side the home Janice loves being outside.

if appropriate, alternate between the room and her chair hourly

Aromatherapy can be given in chair, bed, or soft room

Before Janice goes to bed ensure she will be safe as per the care plan

Complete observation/behaviour chart half hourly. Detail what you have been doing and Janice's reaction to activity.
